### THE MERGA CAREER RESEARCH MEDAL 2022

It is with great pleasure that the Mathematics Education Research Group of Australasia hereby announces the awarding of the MERGA Career Research Medal to ***Professor Merrilyn Goos***, University of the Sunshine Coast, Queensland, in recognition of her outstanding research in mathematics education across a career of over 30 years.

Professor Goos has demonstrated sustained and distinguished achievement in mathematics education research. Her research has advanced knowledge in three areas, namely students' mathematical thinking and classroom interactions; mathematics teacher education and development; and numeracy across the school curriculum.

Professor Goos's research in mathematics education is known for its innovative theoretical approaches and its strong focus on classroom practice. She is committed to working with educational policy makers and practitioners to solve practical problems related to mathematics teaching, curriculum development, and teacher education. The impact of her research beyond academia has been recognised in competitive national assessments in both Australia and Ireland.

Professor Goos's programs of research have led to renowned publications in both national and international journals. Her scholarship is evident in the distinguished invited keynote and plenary addresses she has delivered over the course of her career.

Professor Goos's career has involved research-related contributions to MERGA since the 1990's. In 1993 she was a recipient of the Early Career Award and in 2000 she was a recipient of the Practical Implications Award. She was the treasurer of MERGA from 1999 – 2004 and the president of MERGA from 2010 – 2014. She has been a member of the editorial board of Mathematics Education Research Journal (MERJ) of MERGA since 2005.

Professor Merrilyn Goos is an eminently worthy recipient of the MERGA Career Research Medal in 2022.
